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## PROPERTY RIGHTS ELEMENT

## Goal, Objectives and Policies City of Auburndale Comprehensive Plan

**Update Transmitted December 2021** 

GOAL 1: Consistent with the Statement of Rights in Section 163.3177(6)(i)1, Florida Statutes (2021), the City of Auburndale shall consider private property rights in local decision-making.

Objective 1: The City of Auburndale shall acknowledge private property rights, in addition to all other applicable provisions of the Comprehensive Plan, to ensure their consideration in local decision-making processes.

Policy 1.1: The following statements related to the protection of private property rights shall be considered in the local decision-making process:

- 1. The right of a property owner to physically possess and control his or her interests in the property, including easements, leases, or mineral rights.
- 2. The right of a property owner to use, maintain, develop, and improve his or her property for personal use or for the use of any other person, subject to state law and local ordinances.
- 3. The right of the property owner to privacy and to exclude others from the property to protect the owner's possessions and property.
- 4. The right of a property owner to dispose of his or her property through sale or gift.
