The Auburndale Citizens Academy runs for seven (7) consecutive Tuesday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. beginning February 18<sup>th</sup> through April 1<sup>st</sup>, and ending with a graduation ceremony at the regularly held City Commission meeting on Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00 p.m.

#### CITIZENS ACADEMY: GENERAL INFORMATION

# What is the Citizens Academy?

This program provides our citizens with a deeper understanding of how their City government works, and gives them a look at daily operations and services provided by their local government. The program sets the foundation for residents who are interested in furthering their civic knowledge, especially as it relates to government closest to the people.

# When will classes be held?

Classes are held weekly on Tuesdays, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Classes will begin at 6:00 p.m. Dates are announced on the City's website and are outlined in the application. Participants should attend the kick-off session and graduation, and may miss no more than one (1) class to successfully complete the program. To help ensure the integrity of program, any student who misses two (2) or more classes will be withdrawn from the program and may apply to participate in a subsequent program.

#### What will I do in the Academy?

Classes provide an in-depth "behind the scenes" look at municipal government. Classes will involve presentations by City staff, as well as tours of facilities and key locations within the City that are not normally accessible to the general public. Dinner will also be provided.

# Who is eligible to participate?

Citizens Academy participants must be 18 years or older and live within Auburndale city limits. Participants must meet attendance requirements to successfully complete the program.

#### How are participants selected?

Applications must be submitted to the City Clerk's office by the application deadline. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered. City staff will verify the residency of the applicants.

City staff will review all eligible applications and select class members based on their applications. Class size will be determined by interest and available resources. The City will notify applicants of their selection status by email and/or phone call. If a selected applicant determines they no longer wish to participate, the City reserves the right to replace them with another eligible applicant.

#### What is the cost to participate?

This program is offered free-of-charge.

# What should I wear?

The classes are interactive, so business casual attire is acceptable. We will provide a Citizens Academy nametag for each student. The nametag should be worn during each class, so staff can easily identify class members. We recommend comfortable shoes, as there will be some walking and many activities during the classes.

#### Where are classes held?

Classes will be held at various City facilities. Meeting locations will be communicated to selected participants prior to the class. Participants are responsible for their own transportation to and from the meeting location each session. For some sessions, the City will provide bus or van transportation from the meeting location to other off-site locations. Additional information will be provided when applicable.

# What do I do if I need to miss class?

Participants are allowed to miss one session; however, they are strongly encouraged not to miss any programs if possible.

#### May I bring a guest or relative to these activities?

Because of space limitations, participants may not bring any guests to the classes; however, they will be encouraged to bring guests to the graduation ceremony.

#### What happens after the Academy?

During graduation, you will be recognized by the City Commission during a presentation at a regularly scheduled City Commission meeting. Following graduation from the Auburndale Citizens Academy, you will better understand the role of municipal government in not only Auburndale, but our democracy at-large.
